PRAYER OF INTERCESSION

We confess that when the times of difficulties are upon us, we don't always believe that you will take our burdens. We feel we have to always be in control, trying to demand the desired outcome. Help us to place our trust in you. Remind us that you surround us continually with your care, you never just let us go to drift aimlessly about. Open our hearts and spirits again to your healing powers. For we pray these things in the name of Jesus, the one who will take our burdens and give us peace. AMEN. *Silence is kept*

THE GREAT THANKSGIVING

Jesus said, 'Come to me, all who are weary and whose load is heavy; I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble-hearted; and you will find rest for your souls.'

~Matthew 11:28-29

We are here because Jesus has called us – strangers and friends, locals and visitors, believers and doubters, the certain and the curious. It is always a mixed company that Jesus gathers and invites to his table where, in bread and wine, he meets us and through him we, who are different, are joined to each other.

Holy are you, God of our footloose hearts, and blessed is Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord and Savior. ... As we remember his life and his rest in you, as we celebrate the good news of lightened burdens, we speak of that mystery we call faith:

Christ came, that we may have life; Christ died, so that the burden of death might be lifted from us; Christ was raised to new life, so grace might be revealed to every generation;

Christ will return, to yoke us to God through all eternity.

Pour out your Spirit of rest and shalom upon this bread and this cup, that these gifts might nourish us. we will sing our praise for all eternity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, God in Community, Holy in One. **Amen and amen.**

I invite you to raise a plate of "something" on your table, or a glass of whatever you are drinking, and let us bless it in this way, repeating after me:

Holy Comforter We gather in your name... invited by Jesus... bound together with your Spirit... in union with each other...

Feed our bodies and our spirits... with your comforting presence... so that we might be your comfort to others...

Bless this food... and break open our hearts... Bless this drink... and pour out your love... Amen...
