## **CALL TO WORSHIP**

#### **CALL TO CONFESION**

With our whole heart and our very being we praise you for you are a wise and wonderful God. With nothing more than a word, you created the whirling planets and breathed life into all of creation. You made us in your image, that we might be stewards of this good earth.

Unite us this day with our sisters and brothers around the world as we preach the Gospel and grow in our understanding of discipleship.

Through Christ, with Christ, in Christ, all glory and honor are yours, Holy God, both now and forever more. Amen.

STEWARDSHIP SNIPPET - Oct. 3, 2021 (19<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost, Year B)
