PRELUDE

We invite you to begin your personal preparation at the beginning of the prelude.

CALL TO WORSHIP

ONE: Christ is risen!

ALL: Christ is risen indeed!
ONE: Creator God, we praise you!

ALL: Risen Christ, we greet you!

ONE: Holy Spirit, we are one body by your grace.

ALL: Alleluia! We have seen the Risen Christ! Alleluia! ONE: You alone are holy, O God, and so we worship you. ALL: You have brought Christ up out of the grave.

ONE: You have brought life out of death, hope out of despair.

ALL: We have seen your victory in our lives;

ONE: We have beheld your Risen Christ among us.

ALL: For what we have seen, we give thanks.

ONE: For what is yet to come, we give you our hearts.

ALL: We worship you, and give you ourselves. Alleluia!

PRAYER OF THE DAY

Gracious God, your risen Christ appeared to the disciples and spoke to them. Pass through the locked doors of our fears and our doubts, our need to control and understand. Be present with us; speak to us; open our hearts and minds, that we may hear with joy what you are saying to us today, and give you our hearts. Amen.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Creator God, we confess we have not honored your Creation; we have not loved it as you have loved us. We have thought ourselves separate, not part of your Creation. Forgive our ignorance and arrogance, our greed and destructiveness. Bring us again into the oneness of your Creation;

forgive us, heal our fears and transform our desires, and shepherd us to be good stewards of the gift of life.

Assurance of Pardon

ONE: Christ comes into every shadowed corner of our lives with the light of Easter. Christ comes into the locked rooms of our faults and gifts us with grace and hope.

ALL: Christ comes to fill us with peace, so we may proclaim the good news of mercy and forgiveness for all. Thanks be to God. Amen.

SCRIPTURE READING: from Psalm 148

ONE: Praise God! Praise the Holy One from the heavens;

ALL: praise God in the heights!

ONE: Praise God, sun and moon;

ALL: praise God, all you shining stars!

ONE: Let them praise the name of the Creator,

ALL: who commanded and they were created.

ONE: Praise the Eternal One from the earth,

ALL: you sea monsters and all deeps!

ONE: Fire and hail, snow and frost,

ALL: stormy wind fulfilling God's command!

ONE: Mountains and all hills,

ALL: fruit trees and all cedars!

ONE: Wild animals and all cattle,

ALL: creeping things and flying birds!

ONE: Rulers of the earth and all peoples!

ALL: people of every gender, age and race together!

ONE: Let them praise the name of the Loving One,

ALL: for God's name alone is exalted.

ONE: God's glory is throughout earth and heaven.

ALL: Praise God!

GOSPEL READING: John 20:19-31

When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said,

"Peace be with you."

After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again,

"Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you."

When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them,

"Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

But Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him,

"We have seen the Lord."

But he said to them,

"Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said.

"Peace be with you."

Then he said to Thomas,

"Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe."

Thomas answered him,

"My Lord and my God!"

Jesus said to him.

"Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

Give us today our daily bread.
Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.
Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil.
For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours
Now and for ever. Amen.

POSTLUDE

Stewardship Snippet (2nd Sunday of Easter - Year C) April 24, 2022, John 20:24-29 But Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe." A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

Jesus comes to us as he came to the first disciples, right in the midst of our fear, pain, doubt, and confusion. He comes speaking peace, breathing into our anxious lives the breath of the Holy Spirit. What is more, he keeps showing up. As he came back a week

later for Thomas, Jesus keeps coming back week after week among his gathered disciples — in the word, the water, the bread, and the wine — not wanting any to miss out on the life and peace he gives. And he keeps sending us out of our safe, locked rooms, into a world that, like us, so desperately needs his gifts of life and peace. Donna Weinberg
