ONE: Show us your mercy, O Lord;

ALL: And grant us your salvation.

ONE: Clothe your ministers with righteousness;

ALL: Let your people sing with joy.

ONE: Give peace, O Lord, in all the world;

ALL: For only in you can we live in safety.

ONE: Lord, keep this nation under your care;

ALL: And guide us in the way of justice and truth.

ONE: Let your way be known upon earth;

ALL: Your saving health among all nations.

ONE: Let not the needy, O Lord, be forgotten;

ALL: Nor the hope of the poor be taken away.

ONE: Create in us clean hearts, O God;

ALL: And sustain us with your Holy Spirit.
