SERMON

Stewardship Snippet (6th Sunday after Pentecost - Year C) July 17, 2022 Luke 10: 38-42

Now as they went on their way, he entered a certain village, where a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. She had a sister named Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to what he was saying. But Martha was distracted by her many tasks; so she came to him and asked, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her then to help me. "But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things; there is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her."

For me, this passage in Luke has always been a problem. I'm Miss "Doer" - always facilitating the masses, taking care of the necessities, and of course identifying myself with Martha. Mary is the thoughtful one who allows herself time to take in the moment (sort of like my husband); while I often miss the entire significance in my busyness. Is that a bad thing?
