My name is Jim Visco, and I am the Team Leader of the Communication Commission. The main purpose of the Communication Commission is to oversee all internal and external communications pertaining to PVEC so that all members and others will understand and become interested in participating in our congregation. I accepted this position in late 2018 and I have to say that I did not know what to expect. I located notes that I had taken from some of my first council meetings. We were discussing ways in which we could increase our Youth Group membership, as well as our overall congregation. Several ideas were discussed, for example having an Open House at the church.
