# Update on Financial Condition of PVEC

### Rick Wilson 9/25/22

Cylvia asked me to provide an update on the financial condition of the church. My review is through July because I have not yet seen the August financial statements. At the end of July it had only been one month since Ninabeth left so this review does not reflect much savings of the Minister expenses.

Operating Pledges year-to-date are 11.7% less than July 2021. Our Total Income is slightly ahead of last July because of the increase in Loose Collection and donations for specific purposes such as Vacation Bible School and Altar Flowers.

Expenses are 9.6% higher than July 2021, but as stated earlier we have not yet realized significant savings from the transition from Full-Time Minister to Pulpit Supply. Our deficit year-to-date through July is \$48,886.38.

As I have reported in the past, we have money in the bank and invested with Wespath Investments (investment arm of the United Methodist Church). In addition, we have funds committed for specific purposes on our Balance Sheet including Manse, Capital Improvements, Christian Education, Christian Outreach and Sabbatical Leave.

Our Operating Fund is what remains to operate PVEC after all specific committed funds. Our Operating Fund deficit has increased to \$102,844.21. This is not sustainable longterm. I anticipate we will realize additional expense savings as we transition from fulltime minister to pulpit supply to part-time minister which I believe the Search Committee is considering. As I mentioned during the congregational budget meeting, we have an income problem and not really an expense problem as our expenses are basic and necessary to run the church.

On a more positive note, we have a significant Endowment Fund, especially for a church of our size. These funds are separate from our bank accounts and funds invested with Wespath Investments. Our endowment funds are invested with United Church Funds which is the investment arm of the United Church of Christ. As with the overall

investment market the value of these funds has declined this year. Our Endowment Fund is reserved for a specific purpose, and we can only use the interest earned on the principal which has been gifted to PVEC. If anyone has any questions or wants to discuss our financial condition further you can see me after church, call or e-mail me. Thank you.
