But we have hired her replacement who will be starting next week, training alongside Nikki. 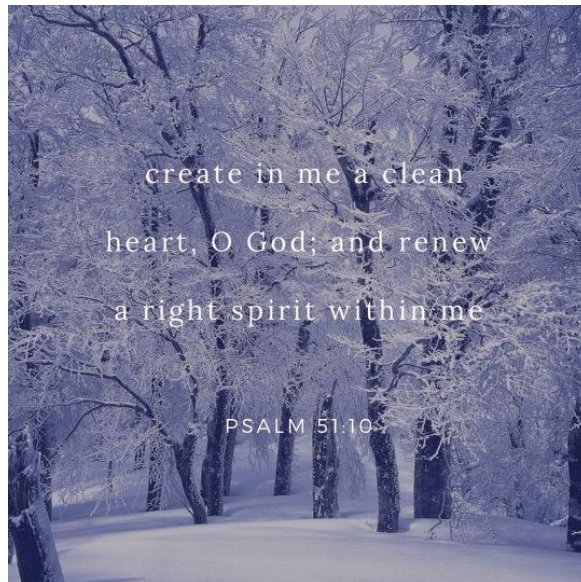
